Boarding

- **\$1100.00 Standard Board**
 - Grain 2-3x per day
 - Hay 4x per day (approximately 16-20lbs per day)
 - Lunch Beet Pulp and/or Alfalfa cubes
 - 2-3x Daily stall cleaning
 - Turn in/turn out
 - Blanketing
 - Application of owner supplied fly spray
 - Application and removal of boots for turnout
 - Electrolytes given twice daily
 - Sand-Rid given the first week of each month to prevent sand colic due to the areas sandy soil
 - Feeding of owner provided supplements
 - Seasonal Solitude supplement for fly prevention (Additional \$20/month)
 - Use of all facility amenities; Polo Field, Jumping Ring, Dressage Ring, Trail System, etc...
 - Evening Night Check and evening hay as needed

- **\$1650.00 Premium Training Board is a tailored program structured around the horse's and rider's needs: includes all standard board amenities plus**
 - Monthly full training (approximately 3-5 lessons and/or training rides a week)
 - Basic Grooming
 - Tack up and after care for scheduled lessons and rides
 - Customized diet if needed (beet pulp, alfalfa cubes, extra hay, etc...)
 - Centurion Blanket treatment as available
 - Laundry Service
 - Includes all Ala Carte Services except body clipping and emergency care and medications

Training Services

- Boarder Lessons
 - \$60 Private or Semi Private Lesson
 - \$50 Group Lesson (3 or more)
 - \$60 Training ride

- \$30 Lunging/Pessoa system session

Horse Show Services

(fees start on departure day and end the day after horses return to farm)

- \$100.00 training per day for less than 2 clients attending. \$75.00 training per day for 2 or more clients attending(includes all professional rides and client coaching).
- \$50.00 Daily full care (feeding, mucking, grooming, tack/untacking, bathing, braid removal, wrapping, night check, etc..)
- \$75.00 Travel day/day off (daily care included)
- Shipping billed at \$1.40 per mile (\$.70 to show/\$.70 home from show), \$50.00 Minimum, unless commercial hauler is used
- Other expenses, such as trainer and groom's hotel expenses, \$40/day/staff member Per Diem, hay/shaving, and tack stall charges will be split between each horse and invoiced. Prices vary according to shows, show locations, and number of classes enrolled/showing in. Show venue charges are separate and paid at each venue before leaving the show. Those fees include entry fee, security, service, stall, etc. You will also have mane/tail braiding charges that will be paid at the show (depending on the number of days and divisions you show in will determine braiding charges).
- A credit card or open check is required with your entry in order to reserve your stall.
- Any cancellations after entries have been sent will still be responsible for their portion of the trainer and groom expenses, and any fees owed to the horse show.
- It is customary to tip your groom
